




### 3.5 TIMES GROWTH OF AGRI-PRODUCTS EXPORT FROM 2006

- ✓ Ukrainian exports of agricultural products reached USD \$14.8 billion last year

### <60% OF EXPORT TRANSPORTED</p> TO THE PORTS BY RAILWAYS


Requirements for renewal of hoppers in Ukraine, units

#### Map of International Road Development in Ukraine




- ✓ Road transportation had a 74% share of total freight transportation in Ukraine

### CONCESSION OF KYIV GRAND RING ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS



Total length	Timeline	Total investments
215 km	4 years	\$6,8 bn (2009 est)

- ✓ The traffic flow across Kyiv reached 30 000 cars per day (2011 estimated)
- ✓ The project divided on several stages, the first priority fragments are:
  - Zhtomir Odessa
  - Odessa Kharkiy
- ✓ The 1 stage of the project will connect Odessa direction with the airport Boryspil
- ✓ The total road length 93,5 km
- ✓ 4 lines, 12 transport interchanges in two levels
- ✓ 1 bridge across Dnipro river and 3 small bridges

The project will unload Kyiv from freight transit transport





### CONCESSION OF THE PARKING IN BORYSPIL AIRPORT

Total parking places	Project completed	Investments
2038	50%	\$10,8 mln

- ✓ At the moment the car parking structure is 50% completed
- ✓ All legal hurdles to permit completion of the garage are done
- Current passenger activity has been impacted by the war
- Ukraine forecasts a recovery to previous passenger levels within the next 2 years
- ✓ The area of the construction is 18 398,0 sq.m.
- ✓ The area of the land plot is 30 000 sq.m.
